

Can I Use Natural-Colors Henna After a Perm? Yes, After perming, wait 2 weeks or 5 shampoos before applying Natural-Colors henna. This will allow the hair to be free of any chemical residue.

Can I Perm After a Natural-Colors Henna? Henna coats the hair shaft and, in some cases, prevents the chemicals in the perm lotion from penetrating. Prior to a perm, remove Natural-Colors Henna.

How Often Can I Use Natural-Colors Henna? Natural-Colors Henna can be used every 4 to 6 weeks. The color will gradually fade in this time.

Are there any chemicals in Natural-Colors Henna Gray Coverage? Natural-Colors Henna Gray Coverage contains a small amount (less than 3% after mixing) of dye. Recently, there have been reports that some chemical hair dyes might be linked to ovarian and breast cancer. Particularly, some people are concerned about black and dark colors that use high concentrations of dye. By using henna combined with a small amount of dye, you get effective, temporary coverage of stubborn gray hair with a minimal amount of chemical exposure.

Can I use Natural-Laxer along with Natural-Colors? Yes. Use Natural-Colors **after** using Natural-Laxer. After using Natural-Laxer wait 2 weeks before using Natural-Colors

Henna comes from small shrubs that are native to the Middle East and North Africa. The leaves are dried and pulverized into a fine powder. Baka uses only the finest quality, organic henna.

Natural-Colors henna coats each strand of hair. The shade of henna is reflected through the hair while enhancing your hair's natural color. It is also a conditioner. The cuticle is smoothed by henna's sealing action, giving hair a polished look. Because the cuticle is tightened and flattened, the hair is protected from atmospheric conditions such as sun and air pollution.

As Natural-Colors henna is applied every 4 to 6 weeks, the color blends naturally and fades gradually so that there is never a noticeable regrowth area.

Can be used in conjunction with Natural-Laxer. After Natural-Laxer penetrates to extract impurities, repair, and smooth the hair, Natural-Colors protects, coats and seals.

Gray Coverage

Natural-Colors for Gray Coverage is a henna based temporary coloring designed specifically to easily and quickly cover gray hair. If you've tried other natural colors, you realize how difficult it can be to cover gray hair. Other, permanent hair colors contain harsh chemicals that can damage your skin and that many people are not comfortable using at home. Natural-Colors for Gray Coverage gives you a safe, effective, temporary solution with a minimal amount of dye. The diluted product is no more than 3% dye.

* Natural-Colors contains no chemicals to strip natural hair color. Therefore, Natural-Colors cannot lighten already dark hair. The blonde tones should only be used on light colored hair.

Natural-Colors should not be used before a Natural-Laxer treatment. Wait (2) weeks after Natural-Colors to do a Natural-Laxer treatment.

Natural-Laxer Treatments can be done immediately **before** Natural-Colors

Do **NOT** apply to eyelashes or eyebrows. Doing so may cause blindness.

Strand Test: Mix 1/2 tsp. Henna with 1/2 tsp of hot water. Apply to 1" section of hair or enough to wrap around a finger. Leave on until dry, Rinse off, Shampoo, Dry

Instructions for Use

Preparation of Paste:

1. Mix entire contents of about ounces of Apple Cider Vinegar. Make thin soupy paste
2. Stir paste thoroughly for 3 minutes.
3. Do not use the remaining paste. Discard immediately.

Skin Sensitivity Test:

1. Cleanse small area of skin behind ear or on inner surface of forearm.
2. Apply small quantity of paste to the area and allow it to dry.
3. After 24 hours wash the area gently. If no irritation is apparent, proceed to use product as directed.

Application:

1. Use **tint brush** or **thin-toothed comb** to apply the paste.
2. Put on **plastic or latex gloves**
3. **Apply to clean (just washed) hair. Hair should either be dry or slightly damp.**
4. Make partitions in the hair to form small bunches and apply the paste to the dry hair from **ROOT TO TIP**. Do not massage into the scalp.
5. After applying Henna, wait for the color development. Allow paste to completely dry (usually about 45 minutes). Can apply conditioning cap.
6. Rinse your hair with water until the excess dye is removed or water runs clear.
7. Follow-up with our Clear Henna Shampoo and Silk Protein Conditioner
